MR L POWER ASKED MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND AMBULANCE SERVICES (HON T NICHOLLS)—

QUESTION

Will the Minister advise (a) total investment in the 2025-26 financial year and (b) investment beyond 2025-26 to improve access to rehabilitation services for pelvic pain and endometriosis care?

ANSWER

The 2025-26 Budget invests a record \$33.1 billion in health services and infrastructure. This health investment is the largest in Queensland's history.

I am advised that development of a pelvic pain clinic is currently in the planning process, with a gap analysis and service modelling work being done. \$13.68 million is allocated to providing access to advanced clinical, surgical and rehabilitation services for persistent pelvic pain, including care for endometriosis. Upon completion of the above activities, exact funding allocations will be determined.
