MR M HEALY ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON D PURDIE)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise between 1 March 2025 and 1 June 2025 (or closest reportable dates), (in table format, reported separately by rate, number, offence and Police District), the (a) rate and (b) total number of unlawful entry with intent offences?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service that the number and rate of unlawful entry with intent offences between 1 March 2025 and 1 June 2025 is detailed in the table below:
