QUESTION:

Will the Attorney-General provide, for each of the last three calendar years, the number of domestic and family violence protection orders made or varied that included a requirement for the respondent to undertake an approved intervention program or counselling?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for Pine Rivers for her question.

I am advised there were: 396 orders made in 2022, 373 orders made in 2023, and 369 orders made in 2024 that required the respondent to undertake an approved intervention program or counselling.
