MR J MARTIN ASKED THE MINISTER FOR SPORT AND RACING AND MINISTER FOR THE OLYMPIC AND PARALYMPIC GAMES (HON T MANDER) —

QUESTION:

With reference to the recent 100-day review into the Brisbane 2032 Olympic and Paralympic Games having left badminton and table tennis, two core Olympic sports that are important to my electorate, homeless—

Will the Minister advise, given the original 2032 bid process specified where these sports would be played, where are badminton and table tennis now going to be held?

ANSWER:

The *2032 Delivery Plan* released by the Queensland Government in March 2025 is not a sports allocation plan, but an infrastructure delivery plan. It identifies the infrastructure and venues the Government will invest in and deliver across Queensland, demonstrating to the International Olympic Committee (IOC) and International Paralympic Committee (IPC) that a wide range of sports can be accommodated during the 2032 Olympic and Paralympic Games (the Games).

All sports and competition venues for the Games are considered provisional until the IOC and IPC confirm the sports that will feature in 2032, which is anticipated to occur in 2026.
