HON M DE BRENNI ASKED THE MINISTER FOR LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND WATER AND MINISTER FOR FIRE, DISASTER RECOVERY AND VOLUNTEERS (HON A LEAHY)—

QUESTION:

With reference to part of the asset allocation pledged to the Mount Cotton Road Fire Station project delivered by the previous Labor Government—

Will the Minister advise of the status and location of the dedicated off-road (iZone) appliance committed as part of the project (reported separately for each day since the Station opened, through to 26 August 2025)?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Fire Department that extracting and collating the requested data on the iZone appliance usage would be an unreasonable diversion of emergency services resources, as it would require the manual interrogation of vehicle logbooks, officer diaries and calendars.
