HON M RYAN ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HOUSING AND PUBLIC WORKS AND MINISTER FOR YOUTH (HON S O'CONNOR)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the proposed Youth Foyer(s) for the Moreton Bay area (see https://caboolturetoday.com.au/youth-foyer-coming-to-caboolture-housing-and-education-support-for-at-risk-young-people/) and suggestions that the LNP Government has selected Redcliffe as the location of a Youth Foyer—

Will the Minister confirm (a) whether the LNP Government has in fact confirmed that Redcliffe is the Moreton Bay location(s) for a Youth Foyer and if not, when the Youth Foyer location(s) will be confirmed, (b) whether the LNP Government has engaged with stakeholders regarding the Moreton Bay location(s) and if so, what location(s) were identified by stakeholders to date and (c) whether the Minister's department has recommended any Moreton Bay location(s) to date?

ANSWER:

The Queensland Government has committed to delivering at least eight new Youth Foyers across the state, including one in the Moreton Bay region.

The Department of Housing and Public Works engaged with stakeholders to inform the delivery of Youth Foyers in Queensland, including service and building design considerations. A needs analysis undertaken by the department informed the selection of the location of Moreton Bay Youth Foyer.

A preferred site for the Moreton Bay Youth Foyer has been identified by department. Further details on the location will be provided in the coming months.
