MS J HOWARD ASKED MINISTER FOR YOUTH JUSTICE AND VICTIM SUPPORT AND MINISTER FOR CORRECTIVE SERVICES (HON L GERBER)

## QUESTION:

Will the Minister provide, the total number of approved FTE positions and the total number of substantively vacant positions, across youth detention centres, (in table format, reported separately by facility) as at 30 June 2025?

## ANSWER:

The Crisafulli government is committed to supporting our hard-working Youth Detention Centre staff. Under our government, recruitment and training activities have been conducted to improve youth detention centre staffing levels and build a confident and capable workforce. Youth Detention Centre approved FTE and substantively vacant FTE as at pay period ending 27 June 2025.

Facility	Approved FTE positions	Substantively vacant positions (FTE)
Brisbane YDC	358.85	Nil
Cleveland YDC	288.60	6.69
West Moreton YDC	131.00	Nil

In relation to the substantively vacant positions at Cleveland YDC as at 30 June 2025, all these positions have now been recruited to and as at 25 July 2025, Cleveland YDC was 5.48 FTE over strength. This is the first time ever that Cleveland YDC has been over strength.
