HON G GRACE asked the Deputy Premier, Minister for State Development, Infrastructure and Planning and Minister for Industrial Relations (**HON J BLEIJIE**) –

QUESTION:

Will the Deputy Premier advise on the number of statutory notices issued by Workplace Health and Safety Queensland inspectors (reported separately by month) for the 2024-25 financial year, including a breakdown of the types of statutory notices issued and enforcement action taken in the circumstance of non-compliance with a notice issued?

ANSWER:

Workplace Health and Safety Queensland (WHSQ) is committed to making Queensland workers, industry and communities healthy, safe, fair and productive. WHSQ inspectors have an integral role in achieving this by monitoring and enforcing compliance with Queensland's workplace health and safety laws by issuing statutory notices.

Table 1 outlines the number of statutory notices issued by month in 2024-25 and notice type.

Table 2 indicates the number of infringement notices issued by month in 2024-25 following non-compliance with an improvement notice.
