MS L LINARD ASKED THE MINISTER FOR NATURAL RESOURCES AND MINES, MINISTER FOR MANUFACTURING AND MINISTER FOR REGIONAL AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT (HON D LAST)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise (a) whether the former Queensland Police Service site in Nundah, on the corner of Bridge Street and Sandgate Road, is still held in the Government Land Register and (b) if so, what this land's future use is intended for?

ANSWER:

- (a) Yes. The site of the former Queensland Police Service in Nundah on the corner of Bridge Street and Sandgate Road (Lot 1192 on Plan SL5591) is recorded in the Government Land Register as an asset of the Department of Housing and Public Works.
- (b) Future use for particular sites is not recorded in the Government Land Register. Any questions regarding the future use of this site should be directed to the Minister for Housing and Public Works and Minister for Youth.
