**MS N BOYD** asked the Deputy Premier, Minister for State Development, Infrastructure and Planning and Minister for Industrial Relations (HON J BLEIJIE) –

QUESTION:

With reference to the Infill Development Strategy committed to under Homes for Queenslanders by the former Labor Government—

Will the Deputy Premier advise (a) if the Infill Development Strategy is still being progressed by the Crisafulli Government, (b) if yes, what is the expected month and year for its delivery and (c) of the \$1.1m allocated to Economic Development Queensland (EDQ) by the former Labor Government to develop the Infill Development Strategy, (i) how much has been expended to date, (ii) how much of that funding has been reallocated and (iii) to what purpose or program has it been reallocated?

ANSWER:

The Crisafulli Government is giving more Queenslanders a place to call home following a decade of decline under the former Labor Government where a 36% drop in new home approvals led to a skyrocketing social housing waiting list.

- (a) Labor's plan to prepare an Infill Development Strategy which followed their Housing Roundtable has been deliberately replaced by the Crisafulli Government's nation-leading, outcomes focussed, Land Activation Program (no Roundtable required). This is the Fresh Start Queenslanders voted for.
- (b) N/A.
- (c) Of the \$1.1 million allocated to Economic Development Queensland (EDQ):
  - (i) approximately \$400,000 was spent. Following enquiries with EDQ, it cannot be demonstrated what the former Labor Government spent this money on.
  - (ii) the remaining \$700,000.
  - (iii) the Crisafulli Government's nation-leading Land Activation Program.
