HON M RYAN ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON D PURDIE)—

QUESTION:

With reference to police housing (that is housing provided to Queensland Police Service personnel)—

Will the Minister advise for the 2025 calendar year (reported separately by month and by police district), (a) the number of repair or upgrade requests that have been submitted by officers in police housing, (b) the number of those requests that have been completed, (c) the number of those requests which were rejected and (d) the number of those requests that remain uncompleted?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) that maintenance requests are reported and actioned by various areas, both internal (such as Capital Assets and Facilities Management Group (CAFMG) and District Housing teams), and external (such as QBuild and Department of Housing and Public Works (DHPW)).

I am further advised that to provide a verified response to the Member's question would require a manual examination of records, which is considered by the QPS to be an unjustifiable use of police resources at this time.

Questions regarding facilities and maintenance works managed by QBuild or DPHW should be directed to the Hon Sam O'Connor MP, Minister for Housing and Public Works.
