**MS M MCMAHON** ASKED THE MINISTER FOR EDUCATION AND THE ARTS (HON J LANGBROEK)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the opening of the new Holmview State School, which was originally scheduled for 2026 with 450 students, but is now scheduled for 2027—

Will the Minister advise (a) current number of enrolments or EOIs for enrolments made as at 1 March 2026, (b) anticipated or projected enrolment numbers for the 2027 school year and (c) what preparations have been made to comply with the requirement outlined at Schedule 1.10 of MID-0923-0721 Decision Notice?

ANSWER:

I am advised:

- (a) There are no enrolments or expressions of interest (EOI) as at 1 March 2026.
- (b) During development of the business case in 2021, preliminary forecasts indicated 303 students would enrol on opening of the new primary school in Holmview in 2026. The most recent enrolment forecasts, prepared by the Queensland Government Statistician's Office, estimate 402 enrolments could be expected across the Prep Year to Year 6 for an opening in 2027. The new school will cater to local growth as it emerges and will reduce the overall enrolment numbers of existing schools within the network.
- (c) To address the requirements of Schedule 1.10 of the MID-0923-0721 Decision Notice, the Department of Education is working closely with Logan City Council to design and plan the works required to be delivered for the school to open and prior to enrolments reaching the threshold specified in the Ministerial Infrastructure Designation condition.
