MS J PEASE ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS (HON B MICKELBERG)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the proposed Moreton Bay Cycleway (from Murarrie to Wynnum) and noting that total funding of \$1.5m has been allocated within the Queensland Transport and Roads Investment Program for a Business Case—

Will the Minister advise (a) the current status of planning work for the Moreton Bay Cycleway, (b) the anticipated timeframe to progress the project to delivery and (c) what engagement has occurred with local governments and regional stakeholders regarding prioritisation and delivery of the cycleway?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for the question.

As part of the masterplan for optimising the cycleway, the Department of Transport and Main Roads completed an options analysis study between Murarrie and Wynnum in late 2025, with utilisation of the local government road network being determined as the preferred option. Local government (Brisbane City Council) and regional stakeholders were consulted throughout the project and involved in key options analysis workshops.

I note that funding was not allocated across the forward estimates under the previous Labor Government to progress this project to the construction stage. If further planning work is required by Brisbane City Council to progress this project, this will be considered in line with statewide project priorities and funding needs.
