HON L LINARD ASKED MINISTER FOR THE ENVIRONMENT AND TOURISM AND MINISTER FOR SCIENCE AND INNOVATION (HON A POWELL)—

QUESTION:

With reference to recent changes made to the Crocodile Management Plan—

Will the Minister advise how many estuarine crocodiles have been removed from their habitats since the changes were implemented in 2025 (reported separately by zone to the nearest date)?

ANSWER:

The Crisafulli Government has made common sense updates to Queensland's Crocodile Management Plan to ensure human safety is prioritised.

As at 9 March 2026, 24 estuarine crocodiles have been removed:

Targeted Removal Zone – 1

General Management Zones – 11

Reportable Removal Zones - 1

Active Removal Zones – 11
