Mr L McCallum asked Premier and Minister for Veterans (Hon. D Crisafulli)—

QUESTION:

Will the Premier advise what Olympics infrastructure and sports will be delivered in the Bundamba Electorate under the Crisafulli LNP Government 2032 Delivery Plan?

ANSWER:

After years of delays, our government has been acting to restore Queenslanders' confidence in the 2032 Olympic and Paralympic Games (the Games). I note the period of time that elapsed between Queensland being awarded the Games and a clear plan being delivered was over 1,300 days.

Our 2032 Delivery Plan sets out a comprehensive, master-planned approach to delivering a Games that all Queenslanders can be proud of and identifies the legacy infrastructure required to deliver a successful 2032 Games across the state.

The 2032 Delivery Plan maximises legacy benefits to Queenslanders. Our \$250 million *Games On!* program supports upgrades at local sporting clubs, improving grassroots sporting infrastructure and facilities throughout Queensland communities, including the Bundamba Electorate.

While the sports program for the Games will be determined later this year, our 2032 Delivery Plan ensures that all parts of the State will have the opportunity to participate and benefit from the Games.
