QUESTION

With reference to the Richlands Toll facility utilised for the storage and distribution of vaccines and the retaining wall incident in December 2025—

Will the Minister advise (a) if any vaccine stocks were damaged, compromised, quarantined or destroyed as a result of the incident, (b) if the answer to (a) is yes, the quantities by vaccine type and by status (e.g. vaccine damaged, compromised, quarantined or destroyed) and (c) the estimated shortfall in vaccine supply to primary care arising from the incident (doses and duration, reported separately by vaccine type)?

ANSWER

I am advised no vaccine stock was damaged, compromised, quarantined or destroyed as a result to the incident. I am advised that any delayed and partially delivered orders have since been fulfilled and supply to Immunisation Service Providers is now fully up to date.
