MS B ASIF ASKED MINISTER FOR YOUTH JUSTICE AND VICTIM SUPPORT AND MINISTER FOR CORRECTIVE SERVICES (HON L GERBER)

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise, for the Staying on Track program and the Regional Reset program (a) a full list of successful tenderers for each program and (b) when each tenderer/operator has or will start taking on young people (reported separately by program and by tenderer/operator)

ANSWER:

The Crisafulli Government is committed to restoring safety where Queenslanders live s preventing the next generation from falling into crime through targeted early intervention and rehabilitation.

The Staying on Track and Regional Reset programs provide intensive support, build accountability and connect young people with education, training and employment pathways to break the cycle of offending.

The Staying On Track program is available statewide, with the following providers engaged:

Anglicare Southern Queensland, Fearless Towards Success, Village Support Limited, Gallang Place Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders Corporation, Kurbingui Youth and Family Development Limited, Life Without Barriers, Jabalbina Yalanji Aboriginal Corporation RNTBC, Namu Collective Pty Ltd, Shine for Kids, 54 Reasons, Bridges Health and Community Care and South Burnett CTC Inc.

All Staying on Track providers have commenced service delivery ('taking on young people'). The Department of Youth Justice and Victim Support routinely monitors operational demands and may increase, vary or add additional providers in specific locations as required.

Currently, the Regional Reset program is available in nine regions, with providers as follows:
