MS J HOWARD asked the Deputy Premier, Minister for State Development, Infrastructure and Planning and Minister for Industrial Relations (HON J BLEIJIE) –

QUESTION:

Will the Deputy Premier advise (expressed in hectares) the total amount of land within each of the four areas of regional interest (Priority Agricultural Areas, Priority Living Areas, Strategic Environmental Areas and Strategic Cropping Areas)?

ANSWER:

The total amount of land in Queensland within each of the four areas of regional interest (as of 9 March 2026) is as follows:

- Priority Agricultural Areas – 5,965,082.20 hectares
- Priority Living Areas – 2,836,829.36 hectares
- Strategic Environmental Areas – 19,782,275.02 hectares
- Strategic Cropping Area – 10,000,526.56 hectares.
