**MS B ASIF** ASKED MINISTER FOR YOUTH JUSTICE AND VICTIM SUPPORT AND MINISTER FOR CORRECTIVE SERVICES (HON L GERBER)

**QUESTION:**

Will the Minister advise when the government will be announcing the successful tenderers for the remaining Crime Prevention Schools in (a) Rockhampton, (b) Townsville and (c) Ipswich?

**ANSWER:**

The Crisafulli Government is delivering new crime prevention schools in Rockhampton, Townsville and Ipswich to ensure the best outcomes for Queenslanders, prevent the next generation falling into crime, and restore order and accountability to the youth justice system.

The Crisafulli Government is rolling out a record \$560 million investment in prevention and rehabilitation initiatives, including \$50 million for Crime Prevention Schools across the Gold Coast, Townsville, Ipswich and Rockhampton. These schools will provide targeted support to young people at risk, helping them re-engage with education, build life skills and reduce the likelihood of future offending.

The schools are on track to start taking enrolments later this year, just as we promised. Successful tenderers will be announced once the tender process is finalised. The Crisafulli Government is committed to procurement processes that respect Queenslanders' money and uphold integrity, probity and accountability at every stage.
