HON S FENTIMAN ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES
(HON D PURDIE)—

QUESTION:

With reference to both the Crime and Corruption Commission and the Queensland Police Union having publicly stated that they are supportive of a Police Integrity Unit—

Will the Minister advise (a) what steps the Crisafulli LNP Government has undertaken to implement a Police Integrity Unit which was a recommendation of the Inquiry into Queensland Police Service responses to domestic and family violence and (b) when will the Police Integrity Unit be implemented?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) that the implementation of recommendations regarding the establishment of a Police Integrity Unit is led by the Department of Justice. As such, I suggest that the Member direct this question to the Hon. Deb Frecklington MP, Attorney-General and Minister for Justice and Minister for Integrity.
