Mr J Martin asked Premier and Minister for Veterans (Hon. D Crisafulli)—

QUESTION:

Will the Premier advise (a) if the Premier or any Ministers have been a passenger on a Queensland Government Airwing (or a contracted services by the Queensland Government Airwing) aircraft which has left Queensland and (b) if so, (i) the dates of the travel and (ii) the name of the Minister (or the Premier) who was the passenger?

ANSWER:

All travel is done in accordance with the requirements of the *Queensland Ministerial Handbook* and the Guidelines for the use of Government Aircraft for Official Transport available at
