**MR M BERKMAN** asked the Deputy Premier, Minister for State Development, Infrastructure and Planning and Minister for Industrial Relations (HON J BLEIJIE) –

QUESTION:

With reference to Round 1 of grants issued under the Residential Activation Fund— Will the Deputy Premier advise (a) the number and dollar amount of grants issued to (i) developers, (ii) local governments, (iii) other (specify) and (b) what proportion of new residences proposed under these agreements will be built (i) on greenfield sites and (ii) as infill or brownfield development?

ANSWER:

The Crisafulli Government's nation-leading and award-winning Residential Activation Fund is delivering 98,000 new homes across Queensland through Round 1 alone following a decade of decline under the former Labor Government where a 36% reduction in new home approvals led to a skyrocketing social housing waiting list.

Round 1 of the Residential Activation Fund includes:

- (a)
  - i. 25 grants approved for 21.7% of the allocated funding.
  - ii. 73 grants approved for 78.3% of the allocated funding.
  - iii. N/A.

(b) A breakdown of greenfield and infill development is not readily available.
