**HON D FARMER** ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON D PURDIE)—

**QUESTION:**

With reference to the 2,265 arrests made by the State Flying Squad—

Will the Minister advise how many were given police bail following their arrest (reported separately by police district, youth offenders and by adult offenders)?

**ANSWER:**

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) that as at 6 March 2026, 2,265 offenders have been charged by the State Flying Squad. Of those, 386 proceedings were commenced by way of arrest.

Of the arrested offenders, I am advised 175 offenders were given police bail and the remaining 211 offenders had their bail objected to by police.

I am further advised of the following breakdown, by police districts, of offenders given police bail following their arrest:
