Mr L McCallum asked Premier and Minister for Veterans (Hon. D Crisafulli)—

QUESTION:

Will the Premier advise the amount of money spent on advertising the government's energy roadmap, including digital and online, listed by advertising medium type?

ANSWER:

The Queensland Government publishes the details of awarded contracts, valued at \$10,000 and over (GST inclusive) on the Queensland Government Open Data Portal in accordance with the *Queensland Procurement Policy 2026* and the *Procurement Guidelines: Contract Disclosure*.

Departmental annual advertisement placement spend is proactively released online each year following the completion of an end-of-financial year audit by an independent auditor: <https://www.premiers.qld.gov.au/right-to-info/published-info/our-finances.aspx>

These disclosures are in line with those of the former Labor government. The government does not propose to divert any public sector resources from delivering for Queensland to alter the disclosure format.
