With reference to the Palm Island Home Ownership Scheme announced by the Minister in January 2025, promising residents would be able to live in their own home—

Will the Minister advise the total number of First Nations people living on Palm Island who are now residing in their own home under the Scheme?

The Palm Island Home Ownership Scheme is the Ministerial responsibility of Sam O'Connor MP, Minister for Housing and Public Works and Minister for Youth and I refer the Member to him for this question.
