MR S KING ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS (HON B MICKELBERG)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise whether the Crisafulli LNP Government is considering an upgrade to Burpengary station park 'n' ride to increase capacity for commuters in my electorate of Kurwongbah?

ANSWER:

I thank the Member for the question.

The Crisafulli Government recognises the important role park 'n' ride facilities play in supporting a connected, integrated, and accessible public transport network for Queensland. Demand for these facilities remains high across South East Queensland (SEQ), and I acknowledge the challenges this can create for some commuters.

Given competing demand, investment in park 'n' ride infrastructure must be prioritised to ensure the greatest overall benefit. My department is committed to investing in suitable park 'n' ride upgrades and expansions across the SEQ transport network to support continued growth and patronage and reduce congestion on the road network. For instance, in October 2024, the Crisafulli Government committed additional funding to accelerate parking upgrades at Narangba Station. Construction is now underway and the project will deliver more than 100 additional spaces for customers in the region.
