HON M FURNER ASKED THE ATTORNEY-GENERAL AND MINISTER FOR JUSTICE AND MINISTER FOR INTEGRITY (HON D FRECKLINGTON)

QUESTION:

With reference to A Call for Change Commission of Inquiry, for all recommendations led by the Department of Justice -

Will the Attorney-General (a) list all recommendations from the report and (b) provide the status of each recommendation (reported separately)?

ANSWER:

This report was handed to the former Labor Government on Monday 14 November 2022. Many of the recommendations in the report were not implemented by the Labor Government in the 23 months and 12 days that followed before the change of government in October 2024.

I am advised that the Department of Justice (DoJ) were responsible for the implementation of the following recommendations from the Commission of Inquiry into Domestic and Family Violence report¹, 20, 21, 22, 50, 51, 52, 65, 66, 67, 76, 78, 68, 69, 70, 71, 72, 73. As of 27 April 2026 recommendations 20, 21, 22, 50, 51, 52, 65, 66, 67, 76, 78 have been closed.
