**MS W BOURNE** ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HOUSING AND PUBLIC WORKS AND MINISTER FOR YOUTH (HON S O'CONNOR)—

QUESTION:

With reference to a recent report by the Property Council of Queensland, showing that Brisbane currently has just one month of private apartment supply available, and considering Ipswich's status both as the fastest growing region in Queensland and that in some parts of Ipswich West, 100% of residents struggle to afford essentials after paying rent (per a report by Digital Finance Analytics)—

Will the Minister advise the current housing stock (public and private, reported separately in table format) in Ipswich West?

ANSWER:

As at 31 March 2026, there are 732 social and community homes in the Ipswich West State Electorate. The Crisafulli Government has work underway on a further 49 social homes within your community.

The Department of Housing and Public Works does not hold data on total housing stock, including private dwellings.
