**MS J BUSH** ASKED THE MINISTER FOR SPORT AND RACING AND MINISTER FOR THE OLYMPIC AND PARALYMPIC GAMES (HON T MANDER) —

**QUESTION:**

With reference to Brisbane preparing to be the host city for the 2032 Olympics, will the Minister rule out the closure, disbanding or relocation of Sports House in Milton, to avoid displacement and potential closure of a number of small sports and recreation organisations?

**ANSWER:**

In 2032 Queensland will host the Olympic and Paralympic Games (Games) across the state.

The *2032 Delivery Plan* details the Government's approach to deliver what Queensland needs for the future, across infrastructure, tourism and grassroots sporting facilities; including the use of the Suncorp Stadium site (which includes the Sports House Brisbane) as a Games venue.

Sports House Brisbane provides professional administration spaces and services for Queensland's state sporting organisations and active recreation industry groups. Sports House Brisbane is highly valued by the industry, and this Government is committed to maintaining the services provided by this venue.
