MR C WHITING ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HOUSING AND PUBLIC WORKS AND MINISTER FOR YOUTH (HON S O'CONNOR)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise, since November 2024 (or the nearest available reporting period) to date (a) how many department-owned land parcels have been sold on the basis they were unsuitable for social housing outcomes, (b) the total proceeds received from these sales and (c) how much of these proceeds have been reinvested into the social and community housing capital program?

ANSWER:

- (a) Since 1 November 2024, no department-owned vacant land parcels have been sold.
- (b) Not applicable – no land parcels have been sold.
