**MR M HEALY** ASKED THE MINISTER FOR FINANCE, TRADE, EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING (HON R BATES) —

### **QUESTION:**

With reference to Round Two of the 2025–26 Skilling Queenslanders for Work program—

Will the Minister advise, since the announcement of Round Two (a) of the 182 funded projects, how many are designed to support skills required for residential construction, (b) what specific trades or occupations these projects target and (c) how many participants are expected to be trained?

### **ANSWER:**

Round Two of the 2025-2026 Skilling Queenslanders for Work program includes 26 projects that have a focus on skills and training in the construction sector. This includes support for participants to gain basic construction skills, employability skills as trades assistants, and to improve their employment in the sector. These projects will be supporting 710 participants.
