HON M FURNER asked the Minister for Families, Seniors and Disability Services and Minister for Child Safety and the Prevention of Domestic and Family Violence (HON A CAMM)—

QUESTION

With reference to A Call for Change Commission of Inquiry, for all recommendations led by the Department of Families, Seniors, Disability Services and Child Safety—

Will the Minister (a) list all recommendations from the report and (b) provide the status of each recommendation (reported separately)?

ANSWER

A Call for Change: Commission of Inquiry into Queensland Police Service responses to domestic and family violence made 78 recommendations primarily for the Queensland Police Service to enhance police capacity and capability to responding to domestic and family violence.

Following machinery of government changes in 2024, seven of the 78 recommendations were transferred to the Department of Families, Seniors, Disability Services and Child Safety.

All seven of these recommendations are finalised.
