MR P RUSSO ASKED THE ATTORNEY-GENERAL AND MINISTER FOR JUSTICE AND MINISTER FOR INTEGRITY (HON D FRECKLINGTON)

QUESTION:

With reference to both the Crime and Corruption Commission and the Queensland Police Union having publicly stated that they are supportive of a Police Integrity Unit – Will the Attorney-General advise (a) what steps the Crisafulli LNP Government has undertaken to implement a Police Integrity Unit which was a recommendation of the Inquiry into Queensland Police Service responses to domestic and family violence and (b) when will the Police Integrity Unit be implemented?

ANSWER:

The Crisafulli Government is committed to ensuring that Queenslanders have full confidence in the police who serve them. This includes having an accessible, transparent and responsive complaints system to deal with police conduct.
