HON L ENOCH ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HOUSING AND PUBLIC WORKS AND MINISTER FOR YOUTH (HON S O'CONNOR)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the Healthy Housing Program supported by both Queensland Health and the Department of Housing and Public Works—

Will the Minister advise the number of projects in each Indigenous Community (reported separately by Indigenous Community) (a) underway and (b) completed between 1 July 2025 and 1 April 2026?

ANSWER:

The Healthy Housing Pilot Program (HHPP) was established to support improved health outcomes in remote and discrete Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities, with pilots across four locations: Badu Island, Yarrabah, Doomadgee and Mornington Island. Learnings from the HHPP will inform the ongoing maintenance program.

Badu Island: a) No projects are currently underway; b) Between 1 July 2025 and 1 April 2026, eight projects were completed, bringing the total number of completed projects on Badu Island to 39.

Yarrabah: a) No projects are currently underway; b) Between 1 July 2025 and 1 April 2026, 46 projects were completed, bringing the total number of completed projects in Yarrabah to 111.

Doomadgee: a) 20 projects are currently underway.

Mornington Island: a) 18 projects are currently underway.
