**MS J PEASE** ASKED MINISTER FOR CUSTOMER SERVICES AND OPEN DATA AND MINISTER FOR SMALL AND FAMILY BUSINESS (HON S MINNIKIN)—

With reference to ongoing concerns regarding fuel supply disruptions and price volatility across Queensland, and the absence of a centralised, publicly accessible source of real-time information—

Will the Minister advise (a) whether the Crisafulli Government will develop and implement a publicly accessible, real-time dashboard to provide information on fuel prices and fuel outages across Queensland, (b) if yes, the expected month and year for delivery and (c) if no, what alternative measures, if any, are being considered to ensure Queenslanders have access to timely and accurate information on fuel availability and pricing?

**ANSWER**

The matters raised by the member relate to the ministerial portfolio responsibilities of the Treasurer, Minister for Energy and Minister for Home Ownership and as such, should be directed by the member to the responsible Minister.

I note on 23 April 2026, the Member for Waterford asked the same question (QON 456-2026) of the Treasurer, Minister for Energy and Minister for Home Ownership, which is due to be tabled by 25 May 2026.
