**HON M DE BRENNI** ASKED MINISTER FOR TRANSPORT AND MAIN ROADS (HON B MICKELBERG)—

**QUESTION:**

Will the Minister commit in the 2026-27 Budget, funding for the Logan City and Brisbane City Councils to jointly prepare a plan to upgrade Rochedale Road through Rochedale South to prepare for further road funding opportunities?

**ANSWER:**

I thank the Member for the question.

I refer to my response to Question on Notice 1508 of 2025 where I acknowledged that this road upgrade was not undertaken under the former government.

The Crisafulli Government recognises the importance of responsible transport infrastructure planning and delivery to the community of Rochedale South.

Rochedale Road—through the suburb of Rochedale South—lies within Logan City and is not a state-controlled road. I refer the Member to my answer to Question on Notice 1508 about Rochedale Road in which it was outlined that this road may be eligible for funding through the Transport Infrastructure Development Scheme (TIDS) under the Roads and Transport Alliance. TIDS funding may be used for construction of or upgrade to local government transport infrastructure, based on 50:50 funding arrangements with local governments.

On this basis, consideration may be given by Logan City to fund this project through the TIDS program, in line with other local priorities.
