MS N BOYD ASKED THE MINISTER FOR LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND WATER AND MINISTER FOR FIRE, DISASTER RECOVERY AND VOLUNTEERS (HON A LEAHY)—

QUESTION:

With reference to the Queensland Government's 2025-26 Budget allocation of \$500,000 for a recreational use feasibility study into Leslie Harrison Dam—

Will the Minister update the House on what progress has been made on the feasibility study since the Budget and when does the Government expect the feasibility study to be completed for public release?

ANSWER:

Since the 2025-26 State Budget, Seqwater has commenced a feasibility study to identify options to enhance recreational opportunities at Leslie Harrison Dam for the benefit of the Redlands community.

As part of this work, Seqwater is consulting closely with Redland City Council and the local Member for Capalaba, Mr Russell Field MP, whose strong advocacy helped secure this initiative.

The Queensland Government is advised Seqwater will provide the outcomes of this work later this year.
