MR C WHITING ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HOUSING AND PUBLIC WORKS AND MINISTER FOR YOUTH (HON S O'CONNOR)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise since 1 November 2024 (or closest reportable date) how many social housing tenancies have been terminated due to rent arrears?

ANSWER:

From 1 November 2024 to 30 April 2026, a total of 36 government managed social housing tenancies were terminated as a result of applications made to the Queensland Civil and Administrative Tribunal (QCAT) on the grounds of rent arrears.

This is consistent with the actions undertaken by the former government. For example, between 1 May 2023 and 31 October 2024, a total of 45 government managed social housing tenancies were terminated as a result of applications made to QCAT on the basis of rent arrears.
