MR L POWER ASKED THE MINISTER FOR HOUSING AND PUBLIC WORKS AND MINISTER FOR YOUTH (HON S O'CONNOR)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise, of the \$5.6 billion allocated over four years, along with ongoing funding of at least \$500 million per annum from 2029–30 to deliver 53,500 social and community homes by 2044, how much funding is allocated to the delivery of the 10 new and replacement domestic and family violence shelters?

ANSWER:

The Queensland Government has committed a record \$5.6 billion over four years, along with ongoing baseline funding of at least \$500 million per annum from 2029-30, towards the delivery of 53,500 social and community homes by 2044. This includes the delivery of ten new or replacement domestic and family violence (DFV) shelters.

The capital funding allocation for the delivery of the DFV shelters is commercial-in-confidence to support competitive procurement processes for building contractors for the projects.
