**Mr M Berkman** asked the Deputy Premier, Minister for State Development, Infrastructure and Planning and Minister for Industrial Relations (HON J BLEIJIE) –

QUESTION:

With reference to the Crisafulli LNP Government's proposed new stadium at Victoria Park—

Will the Deputy Premier advise (a) what was the estimated total construction cost when the stadium was first announced in March 2025, (b) has that estimate been reviewed to account for rising construction and fuel costs and (c) what is the current estimated total construction cost for the Victoria Park stadium?

ANSWER:

On 8 March 2025, the Games Independent Infrastructure and Coordination Authority (GIICA) finalised their report following their 100 Day Review of 2032 Olympic and Paralympic Games (Games) Infrastructure. In GIICA's report, it recommended Victoria Park as the preferred location for the Main Stadium at an estimated cost of \$3.785 billion.

On 25 March 2025, the Crisafulli Government released the 2032 Delivery Plan in response to the 100 Day Review and accepted GIICA's Main Stadium recommendation.

The Main Stadium will be delivered within the \$7.1 billion Games Venues Infrastructure Program, agreed to on 20 August 2025 by the Queensland and Australian Governments, under the Intergovernmental Agreement for Games venue infrastructure. The budget for the Main Stadium project is \$3.785 billion.
