HON C DICK asked the Deputy Premier, Minister for State Development, Infrastructure and Planning and Minister for Industrial Relations (HON J BLEIJIE) –

QUESTION:

Will the Deputy Premier advise why key Request for Proposal process documentation for the Land Activation Program, including key dates and submission deadlines, is (a) not publicly available and (b) only accessible to eligible proponents participating in the market process?

ANSWER:

The Crisafulli Government's nation-leading Land Activation Program (LAP) uses a probity-based process to ensure integrity, fairness, protect sensitive information, and deliver value-for-money outcomes for Queenslanders.

In accordance with this probity-based process, Request For Proposal (RFP) documentation which contains commercially sensitive and site-specific material is available to eligible proponents who agree to be bound by the obligations of the probity process. This is a practice that has been in place for a number of years, including under the former Government, and is not specific to the LAP.
