DR B O'SHEA ASKED MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND AMBULANCE SERVICES (HON T NICHOLLS)—

QUESTION

With reference to the mobile breast screening service provided through Breast Screen Queensland—

Will the Minister advise how many breast screens were conducted in the 2025 calendar year, reported separately by month?

ANSWER

I am advised that BreastScreen Queensland operates in more than 260 locations across Queensland through a network of services, including 11 screening and assessment services, 23 satellite screening locations and 11 mobile screening units (including a 4WD screening unit).

In January 2025, the Crisafulli Government unveil the new \$1 million mobile screening van which is giving regional and remote communities easier access to screening services.

I am advised that in 2025, just under 20% of total screens were conducted in mobile screening units, broken down as follows:

January 3,620; February 4,589; March 3,834; April 3,528; May 4,172; June 4,265; July 4,659; August 4,486; September 4,497; October 4,102; November 4,318; December 1,648.
