**MS C MCMILLAN** ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES (HON D PURDIE)—

**QUESTION:**

Will the Minister advise, reported separately by month since 1 November 2025, the number of police recruits who commenced the recruit training program who have subsequently (a) withdrawn from the program prior to graduation and (b) been deemed unsuitable to continue the program prior to graduation?

**ANSWER:**

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) that:

- (a) the number of recruits who commenced the program on or after 1 November 2025 and separated prior to graduation, by month, is as follows:

Recruits who Separated	Nov-25	Dec-25	Jan-26	Feb-26	Mar-26	Apr-26
	0	3	2	4	11	3

Note: All recruits who leave the QPS prior to graduation are recorded as having separated. Separation records do not reflect the reasons for separation.

- (b) The QPS does not record resignation information in terms of recruit suitability. To identify the reasons for an individual recruit's separation would require a manual examination of records and the release of this information would be inconsistent with the *Information Privacy Act 2009* and QPS privacy principles.
