MRS KING asked the Deputy Premier, Minister for State Development, Infrastructure and Planning and Minister for Industrial Relations (HON J BLEIJIE) –

QUESTION:

Will the Deputy Premier advise whether government-owned land released to the private market under the Crisafulli Government's Land Activation Program is offered, in the first instance, to the Department of Housing and Public Works for the purpose of delivering social and affordable housing?

ANSWER:

The Crisafulli Government is giving more Queenslanders a place to call home following a decade of decline under the former Labor Government where a 36 per cent drop in new home approvals led to a skyrocketing social housing waiting list.

The former Labor Government also knowingly sat on vacant, surplus Government land that could be used for housing, further contributing to Labor's Housing Crisis.

The primary objective of the Land Activation Program is to increase the overall supply of housing across the State. Consultation with the Department of Housing and Public Works will occur throughout the process.
