QUESTION

With reference to the Women's Safety and Justice Taskforce reports 1 and 2—

Will the Minister list all recommendations from these reports and provide the status of each recommendation (reported separately) as at 31 January 2026 (or closest date available)?

ANSWER

Restoring safety where you live is a key Queensland Government objective for the community. As part of this commitment, the Queensland Government is taking strong action to address domestic and family violence, including progressing the Women's Safety and Justice Taskforce (WSJT) reform activity.

The next WSJT reporting period is 31 March 2026. Release of this reporting will be subject to Cabinet consideration.
