**Mr S Knuth** asked Premier and Minister for Veterans (Hon. D Crisafulli)—

QUESTION:

With reference to Covid Vaccinations being removed by the Queensland Government and assurances that no former Government employee will be discriminated against on returning to the State Public Service, and noting instances of discrimination have been highlighted on numerous occasions to the government—

Will the Premier act to ensure valuable, highly qualified public service employees are provided with a fair pathway for a return to work?

ANSWER:

There are no vaccine mandates currently in place, as I advised in the House during Question Time on 12 June 2025.

As advised in response to Question on Notice 762-2025 and in accordance with standard recruitment and selection practices, former employees who were terminated for this purpose are welcome to apply for roles within the Queensland Government.
