MS J BUSH ASKED THE MINISTER FOR WOMEN AND WOMEN'S ECONOMIC SECURITY, MINISTER FOR ABORIGINAL AND TORRES STRAIT ISLANDER PARTNERSHIPS, AND MINISTER FOR MULTICULTURALISM (HON F SIMPSON)—

QUESTION:

Will the Minister advise the number of staff within the Department of Women, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Partnerships and Multiculturalism temporary contracts (reported separately by both headcount and FTE) as at 1 January 2025, 1 July 2025, 1 January 2026 and 1 July 2026 (or closest reportable dates)?

ANSWER:

I am advised that there were 15.9 full-time equivalents employed on a temporary basis in the Department of Women, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Partnerships and Multiculturalism in the last full fortnight of the June 2026 quarter.

I am advised that this level of disclosure is the same as that which applied in the last year of the former government.

This government does not propose to divert any public sector resources from delivering for Queensland to alter this disclosure format.

The information for the last full fortnight of the June 2026 quarter will be available in the 2025-2026 annual report of the Department of Women, Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander Partnerships and Multiculturalism, which will be tabled later this year in line with legislative requirements.
