MRS M NIGHTINGALE ASKED MINISTER FOR POLICE AND EMERGENCY SERVICES
(HON D PURDIE)—

QUESTION:

With reference to answer to Question on Notice No. 1329 of 2025—

Will the Minister provide the number and percentage of total assault victims with a domestic violence flag for the period from 1 January 2024 to 31 January 2025, where (a) the respondent was a female and (b) the respondent was a male?

ANSWER:

I am advised by the Queensland Police Service (QPS) that the number and percentage of total assault victims with a domestic violence flag for the period from 1 January 2024 to 31 January 2025 by offender sex is as outlined in the following table:

Notes:

1. This data is preliminary and may be subject to change.
2. Figures do not represent a unique person count as a person may be the victim of more than one offence in the period.
3. Data for 'with DV flag' refers to assault offences where the domestic violence indicator was 'yes'.
4. Not all offences will have a linked offender. A victim of one assault offence may have involved multiple offenders of different sex.
5. Female offender / male offender reflects the number of victims for assaults with a DV flag, where there was at least one offender who was female/male respectively.
6. Data where the offender was neither male nor female has not been shown but are included in the number of victim counts.
7. Percentage for female/male offender is calculated by dividing the number of female/male offenders with a DV flag by the total number of victims for assault offences with a DV flag.
