MS C MULLEN ASKED MINISTER FOR WOMEN AND WOMEN'S ECONOMIC SECURITY, MINISTER FOR ABORIGINAL AND TORRES STRAIT ISLANDER PARTNERSHIPS AND MINISTER FOR MULTICULTURALISM (HON F SIMPSON)

QUESTION:

With reference to Page 44 of Budget Paper 4 of the 2026–27 Queensland Budget, and the \$1.5m Partnership Package—

Will the Minister advise (a) the approved organisations receiving funding under this Package and their stated funding purpose and (b) the amount of funding allocated to or received by each organisation?

ANSWER:

The Queensland Government is proud to provide funding of \$1.5 million in 2026–27 to support community centred initiatives that strengthen community partnerships and support the safety, wellbeing and integration of migrants.

Organisations receiving funding under this package are:

1. \$1.3 million to Village Support Limited to continue operation of the African Villages program, with hubs in Moorooka, Geebung and Redbank Plains.
2. \$125,000 to the Queensland Program of Assistance to Survivors of Torture and Trauma (QPASTT) for continuation of the Peace Leadership Program for young people.
3. \$105,000 to continue Welcoming Australia's targeted approach to break down barriers to participation for culturally and linguistically diverse communities through engagement with local governments, sporting clubs and community spaces.
