MS C MCMILLAN asked the Minister for Families, Seniors and Disability Services and Minister for Child Safety and the Prevention of Domestic and Family Violence (HON A CAMM)—

QUESTION

Will the Minister advise the number of staff within the Department of Families, Seniors, Disability Services and Child Safety on temporary contracts (reported separately by both headcount and FTE) as at 1 January 2025, 1 July 2025, 1 January 2026 and 25 June 2026 (or closest reportable dates)?

ANSWER

I am advised that there were 607.16 full-time equivalents employed on a temporary basis in the Department of Families, Seniors, Disability Services and Child Safety in the last full fortnight of the June 2025 quarter.

I am advised that this level of disclosure is the same as that which applied in the last year of the former government.

This government does not propose to divert any public sector resources from delivering for Queensland to alter this disclosure format.

The information for the last full fortnight of the June 2026 quarter will be available in the 2025-2026 annual report of the Department of Families, Seniors, Disability Services and Child Safety, which will be tabled later this year in line with legislative requirements.
